


Ballycrenode Carrolls

Genealogical Office in Dublin: circa 1960, found abstract of will of William of Ballycrenode – original burnt in 1922 Four Courts fire –destroying 700 years of public records. Probated in 1706, the will names those in the pedigree below.



Leases of farms of Ballycrenode, Ballinamore, Lissen and Ballyvanrane to daughter Elizabeth and husband James Carroll. Right and Estate in Lissagarif to nephew John son of Daniel.

According to William Curtis Carroll, Elizabeth and husband James conformed to the COI in 1706 probably in order to receive their full inheritance.

Daughter Mary Carroll and husband Kean Carroll were dead by 1706. Kean may have been Kean of Aghagurty. If so his son Daniel would have been Daniel I of Marlboro.

Gravesite: In 1964, William Curtis Carroll Jr. visited and photographed William Carroll's tombstone. Located in the ruins of Kilkeary Parish Church, ~3m SE of Nenagh in Co. Tipperary the stone reads: "IHS. Here lies the body of William Carroll of Ballycrenode, Gentleman, who died the 19th day of Feb. anno dom: 1706. Requiescat in pace". Note: a gentleman in English heraldic law is a man entitled to bear arms but who is not a member of the nobility.

Memoir: Patrick Boland Carroll (1804-1890) wrote a family memoir claiming his ancestors came from Ballycrenode (which was inherited as real estate but was lost shortly after Cromwell's War) in the 17th and 18th centuries. He also claims that every second generation a son was named William to honor the grandfather. Also claimed that unlike their Catholic tenant farmer family, several Carroll families of more well to-do cousins came from Ballycrenode: Carrolls of Tulla and Lissenhall and ancestors of Eliza Carroll who married Dr. James Dempster of Nenagh in 1818. Pedigrees of both families exist. The following pedigree is that of Patrick's and W. C. C. Jr.

William Carroll m. Sarah Ryan – raised family and died in Cloncannon near Moneygall

Patrick Carroll m. Anne Wilds – leased in Barnane near Templemore for 3 generations (circa 1740-1833)

William Carroll m. Mary Boland – circa 1775-1825, settled c. 1806 in Ballincurra or Ballicara near Templederry.

Patrick Boland Carroll James Carroll (1819-1892) Descendants lived here until 1912 – Daphne Carroll's family etc.

Most of Patrick's gen. emigrated circa 1825-1850 including Patrick and his brother James.

The family settled in Maryland and Virginia.

It is thought that William Carroll of Cloncannon was the grandchild (without identified parents) mentioned in the will of William Carroll of Ballycrenode.
