HUSBAND - Francis Fortescue
SOURCE:

Mentioned in sons baptism record (but mothers name not mentioned).

Based on the fact that his son was born in 1709, it is assumed that Francis may have been born around 1680 - 1690.

Left a will, dated 24 September 1743, proved 28 July 1779 which states that he is of Baulking.

It states that he died in the year 1769.

The will does not mention a wife (probably deceased) but does mention his son Francis and other relations.

I believe that he was the first Fortescue to move to Baulking as he was not born or married or buried there. He probably moved there after he was married, and was buried back in the place where he was born (although he probably died in Baulking?)

He could have been part of the Fortescues in Buckland? From the IGI, we have a William Fortescue Christened on 14 Jan 1693, son of John Fortescue and Mary. This William could be the one that we have the will of. The IGI extraction only starts at 1691, so there may not be records of the earlier children (Francis and John?) - This was checked at the BRO and there is a Francis Fortescue (brother of William) that was born 1703 in Buckland - so it couldnt have been ours.

There are certain bishops transcripts for Buckland that do exist in Trowbridge, Wiltshire RO.

Checked for him in the following other towns in Berkshire via the transcripts / indexes that exist in the BRO:

Found some Fortescues, but cant find our Francis that died in 1769.

Checked London Marriage Index (1521-1869) but no matches.

Looked through all branches of the Fortescue family in the comprehensive book by Sir Thomas Fortescue - but they dont seem to match as well.

Tried to look for a clue through the names of the witnesses on his will -

George Cook
Richard Gosling
Joseph Cook Snr

Found a Richard Gosling (a rare name) born in London in 9 June 1672 - could be the one? (No way of knowing) If this was his friend - perhaps there is a chance he was also born on London?

Also checked the "National Burial Index" - No Francis died the year mentioned in his will (1769) - the closes is a Francis who died 1755 in Longowth Berkshire. This is interesting as Longworth is not far from Baulking (kind of near Buckland).

There is a slight chance that this could be our man - except the death dates are quite out of sync.

Looking through the transcripts for Longworth, we found that there was another Francis that died in 1704, who was the son of another Francis! There is obviously a long lie of Francis's in this area!

Baptisms - Fortescue Francis - son of Francis - April 10 1709

Cant find marriage in Uffington / Baulking, and nothing on IGI for 1740 +/- 20 years.

Burials - Fortescue Francis, 83, old age, Baulking, 10 Feb 1793

Buried in St Marys church, Uffington in the Fortescue section:

"To the memory of Francis Fortescue who departed this life 5 Febuary 1793 aged 84"

"Here lyeth the body of Joseph Cook who departed this life 17 July 1780 aged 71 years. Also here lyeth the body of Sarah the wife of Joseph Cook of this parish who departed this life 1st September 1743 aged 30 years. Their children Sarah, Mary, Henry, Edmond."
