 Almighty God to bestow upon me I Give and dispose thereof as followeth first I will that my Debt and  
 Funeral Charges shall be paid and discharged from I Give unto <sup>my</sup> Daughter Francis <sup>Francis</sup> the now Wife of  
 William Abbot of Abington in the County of Berks Esq. the sum of twenty pounds to be paid  
 unto her by my Executors hereafter named within one year after my Death from I Give unto a  
 my Grandson Henry Cook and Edmund Cook Sons of Joseph Cook Junior of Wfington in aforesaid  
 County the sum of ten pounds apiece of good and lawfull money to be paid to their said  
 Father by my Executors hereafter named within one year after my Death And my Will further is  
 that the same shall be put to Interest for them by their said Father till they shall Attaine their  
 respective Ages of Twenty one Years from I Give unto my Granddaughter Mary Cook Daughter  
 of the said Joseph Cook the sum of five pounds of good and lawfull Money to be paid to her said  
 Father within by my Executors hereafter named with one year after my Death And my  
 Will further is that the same shall be put out to Interest by her said Father for her use till  
 she shall Attaine the age of Twenty one Years And my Will further is that if either of my  
 said Grandchildren Henry Cook Edmund Cook and Mary Cook shall happen to die before he she  
 or either of them shall Attaine his her or their respective ages of Twenty one Years as  
 aforesaid that then and in such case my Will is that his her or their Legacies and the
