and Testament All the rest and residue of my personal Estate Goods and Chattels whatsoever I do  
give and bequeath unto my Loving Son Francis Fortescue of Baulking aforesaid whom I do  
make full and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament And I do hereby revoke  
disannul and make void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore In Witness Whereof  
I the said Francis Fortescue to this my Last Will and Testament have set my hand and seal  
the four and twentieth day of September the seventeenth year of the Reign of our Sovereign  
Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of  
the Faith and so forth and in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and forty three
