The last general mobilization of the Old Undivided Dublin Brigade, was held on the occasion of Tadgh Barry's Funeral in 1921, seventeen years ago. As a member of that Brigade, the premier Unit of the Irish Republican Army, you are asked to attend the next General "Mobilization" on Sunday next, 15th January, 1939, in the Olympia Theatre, Dame Street, at 11.30 a.m. sharp.

It is the earnest hope of those convening the "Parade", that every man who ever served with the Brigade will make any sacrifice necessary to meet his old comrades on this occasion.

The Brigade is not being called together for sentimental reasons, but because issues of a most vital nature are confronting the Nation, and it is most essential that the Old I.R.A. and the elements they represent see clearly the courses of action they must pursue.

Ireland's attitude in the inevitable war which threatens Europe in the near future is of more importance to us of the Old Irish Republican Army than any other elements in the Country, and we must leave no doubt as to what our attitude should be.

Other equally important questions will be discussed, and it must be emphasised, now, that no personal considerations, no political affiliations, past or present, should interfere with your attendance at the first United Front shown by the Irish Republican Army since the disaster of 1922.

As it has been impossible to get in touch with all Old I.R.A. men, you are earnestly requested to invite any old members of the Dublin Brigade known to you and to advertise the meeting to the best of your ability.
