

publish<sup>and declare</sup> this my last will & testament in manner following in the first place I committed my soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator in all humble request its future & happiness as in the disposal of a being infinitely good & my body I commit to the earth to be decently interred & buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named & as to my worldly Estate I leave it as God pleased God to bless me with & I do give & dispose thereof as followeth that is to say I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas & Mary Summons & Mary Summons wife of my two brothers Thomas Summons & John Summons all my wearing apparel of all sorts equally to be divided between them & also all the other also from & after payment of my just debts funeral expenses the charges of & proving this my will & other indent charges in the execution thereof I give & bequeath all & every my ready money & ornaments for money & debts plate & other goods Bedding & household stuff & furniture of household goods Cattle & personal Estate whatsoever & whatsoever unto my two brothers Edward & Thomas & Thomas & Thomas now residing in London to be equally divided between them & also all the & do hereby make & appoint my said brother Edward & Thomas Executors of this my last will & testament & I desire that to be continued as & for my last will & testament in witness whereof I the said Richard Blunden the testator have to this my last will & testament set my hand & seal this twelfth day of August in the year of our Lord 1804 & in the forty second year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. & I have signed sealed published & declared by the within named Sarah Blunden the testatrix as & for our last will & testament in the presence of us who in the presence aforesaid & subscribed our names as witnesses thereto - Mary Summerton

Proved at London 10<sup>th</sup> August 1814 before the Reverend Samuel Ruse Minister of the Gospel & Surrogate by the Oath of Edward & Thomas the brothers & sole Executors for whom Assent was granted & sworn duly to do so.
