

SAW ROSUM SHOOT STARMAN WITH GUN

MARTIN KRIEL TESTIFIES HE
SAW THE DEFENDANT KILL
STARMAN AT PISEK.

Grafton, N. D., Feb. 23.—Martin Kriel was the star witness today in the trial of Joseph Rozum for the murder of Louis Starman at Pisek a few weeks ago. Kriel testified that he saw the defendant pull a revolver from his pocket and shoot Starman. The shooting occurred in a blind pig and the witness had arrived there a short time before it occurred. Kriel's testimony was not completed when court adjourned this evening.

This forenoon was spent in going over details as to the location of the blind pig in which the shooting occurred. Dr. Glaspell was the first witness called this afternoon. He had officiated at the post mortem held over the body of Starman after the shooting. The brain of the murdered man was produced in court. It contained the bullet which had caused Starman's death. Dr. Glaspell testified to taking it from the skull of Starman.

The jury will be in charge of the sheriff until after the trial. Cots have been provided for the members and they will be lodged in the court room.
