 of my property of whatsoever or kind soever I give devise and bequeath to my dear and
 wife Mary Ann Acomb her Executors Administrators and assigns absolutely for
 her own benefit she her heirs maintaining supporting and educating our Children so far as
 as she may be able And of this my Will I nominate and appoint my Brother in Law
 Thomas Britton Willcox and James Pallett Executors and hereby revoking all former
 and other Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made I do declare this only to be
 my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will set a
 my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one
