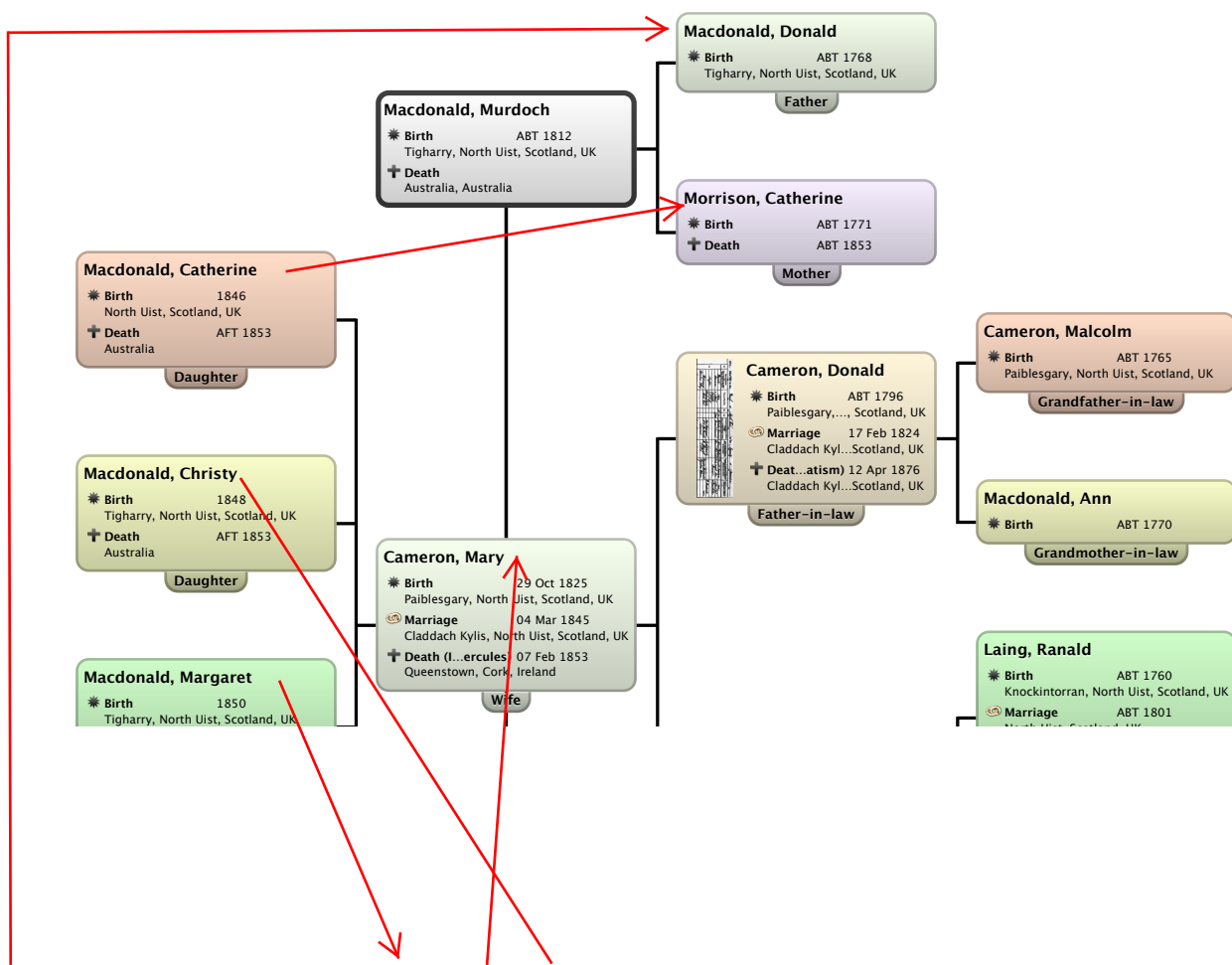

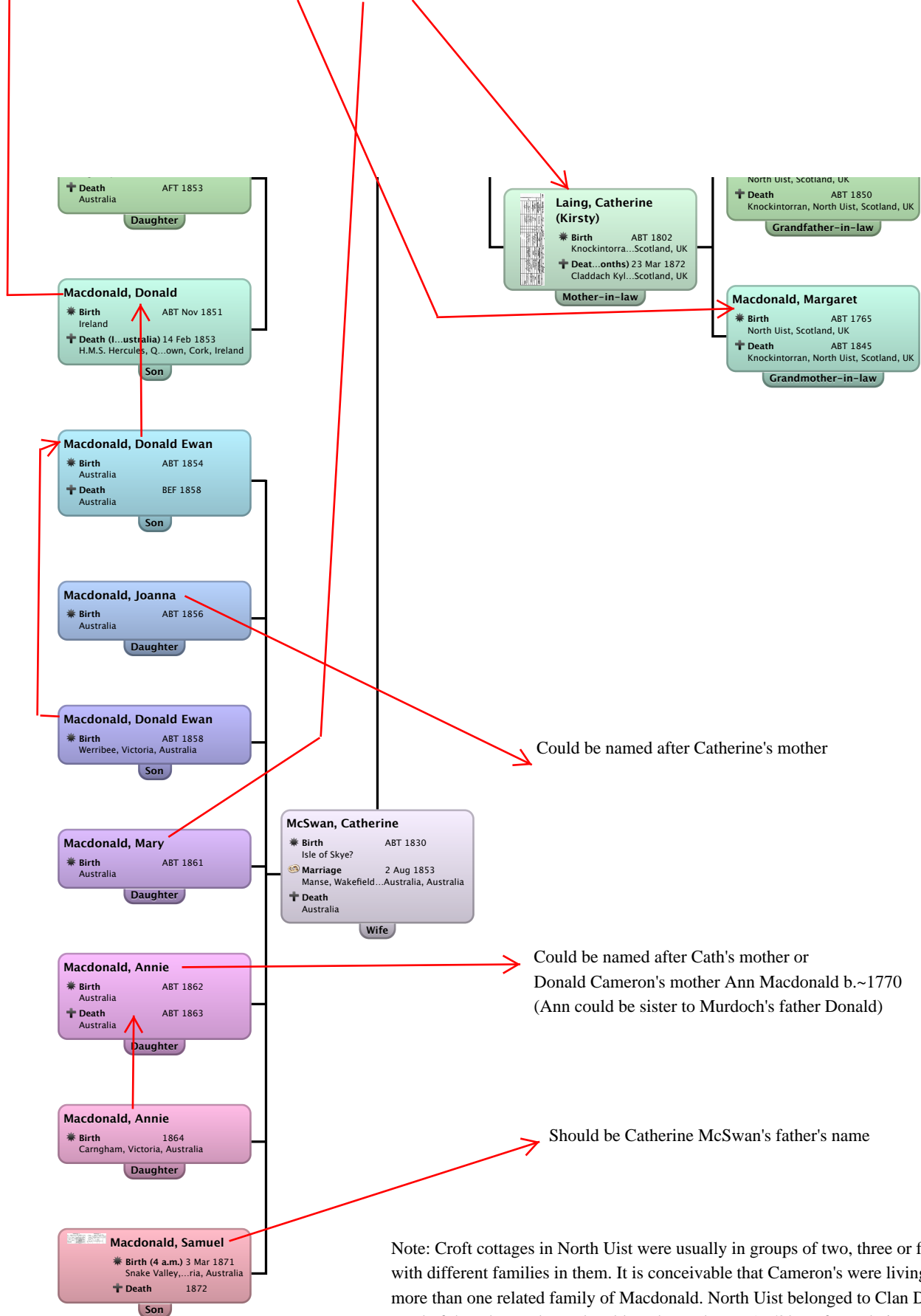

## Hourglass Chart





There were two Catherine McSwan immigrants to Australia. One on HMS Hercules in 1853 (Campbeltown to Victoria), the other in 1854 (Liverpool to Portland Bay) on the ship Edward Johnstone. Both girls were the same age of approx. 24. Murdoch probably met the Hercules Catherine on board, whereas he would need to meet the second one somewhere in Australia much later.
