Extracts from **Gregory** Jackson's Will supporting the above family relationships:

(written in 1780) I Gregory Jackson of Mary Clist in the county of Devon Esquire (...) my dear wife Dorothy (...) my brothers William Jackson, George Jackson & James Jackson (...) my sister Maragaret Brand (...) my sister Mary Edwards (...) my niece Elizabeth Hatherly (...) my nephew William Collins Jackson, my niece Ann Jackson and Margaret Jackson children of my brother George Jackson (...) William Bickford Jackson son of my said brother James Jackson (...) William Jackson son of my brother William Jackson
Executors are his brother James Jackson and "trusty servant James Pitts"

Part B (written 15 June 1782 – he's now living in Exeter) includes refs to above people but adds my niece Dorothea Jackson daughter of my brother George.

Thursday, June 11, 1807 2277 Y3200649873 Jackson William Beckford
Merchant, Dealer and Chapman City of Exeter Had estates in Newfoundland, and occupied a
dwelling house on Southernhay, City of Exeter. In 1817 was residing in Trepassey, Newfoundland.

Thursday, May 26, 1808 2329 Y3200650374 Jackson James
Lime-burner, Dealer and Chapman Topsham occupied a dwelling-house in High Street, Topsham

Worth noting that these bankruptcies were most probably caused by the loss of trade with Newfoundland mainly due to Napoleonic war.
