THE deputy Sydney Coroner held an inquiry on Saturday into the death of Joseph Kavanagh, 48, grocer, of Woolloomooloo. On the previous day the deceased, who was a passenger on the Manly ferry boat Fairlight, was seen to suddenly jump into the harbour near North Head. A rescue was effected, but animation could not be restored.

Monday, 4 September 1899

A Tragic Death

The city coroner held a magisterial inquiry on Saturday in connection with the death of Joseph Kavanagh, who was drowned in the harbor on Thursday. Evidence showed that, deceased jumped from the steamer Fairlight, by which he was a passenger from Manly. The coroner found a verdict of suicide while suffering from, ill-health.

Browne (instructed by Messrs Vindin and Littlejohn), who represented the defendant, said that negotiations for settlement having failed, the suit would probably be contested. He asked for an

adjournment till, Friday, which his Honor granted, the injunction being continued till then.
