

## WRECK OF A WEXFORD VESSEL.

The schooner *Henry*, Ambrose Butler master, left this port on Friday last, on her voyage to Gloucester, with a cargo of oats, and, when off the Bishops, on Saturday, she met a violent gale, which carried away her masts and bowsprit, with every spar and sail. On Sunday she was met by a Jersey fishing boat, which took her in tow, and brought her to the Carne roads, where she remained until intelligence of her position reached this town. The steam tug *Erin*. Captain Blake, was then despatched, and brought her up to our quay on yesterday evening. The *Henry* is the property of Mr Devereux. We are happy to state that no accident occurred to any person on board. The captain was standing at the wheel when one of the masts fell at his feet.
