REDMOND (REDMAN), which see. Charles Pryse younger  
operated under his own name, (1873-1888), at 84 Aston St.

Charles Pryse granted British Patent No. 2018 of 6 Sept.  
1855 in conjunction with Paul CASHMORE for a percussion  
revolver, which was retailed by George H Daw of 57  
Threadneedle St. London and which is known as the 'Daw  
revolver.' He also received Patent No. 4421 of 15 Nov.  
1876 for a revolver mechanism. (This was Charles the  
younger.) This patent formed the basis for the well-known  
centre-fire Pryse revolver.
