them belonging And I do likewise give her five hundred  
pounds to be due and payable at the end of one year next  
after my decease And she shall have power to dwell in  
my Mansion House of Saint Lawrence till my Son  
attains or might have attained the age of one and  
twenty years if she so long shall be unmarried I do  
give to my sister Elizabeth fifty pounds To my sister  
Ley fifty pounds To Jane Ley her youngest Child or  
(born after her fathers death) two hundred pounds  
to be paid to her Mother for her use and benefit when  
she the said Jane shall be ten years old And if her  
Mother dye before Then I devise my Executors and  
Trustees to dispose of the said two hundred pounds as  
they shall think best for the benefit of the said Jane  
I give to my Nephew Sir William Sandres Baronett one  
hundred pounds which last mentioned legacies I would  
have paid so soon as well may be whereas I have setted
