

settled to such or his like use and in like manner as I
have herein before devised my said farm at Warham
(Except only as to my wife's Estate therein for her life as
aforesaid) Provided and my will and meaning is that if I
shall have any other son then and in such case if my
said son George shall happen to have no son and but
one daughter born before his death or after, he shall
have power whether of full age or under (Notwithstanding
his minority) by any writing under his hand and seals
attested by two or more witnesses to charge any of the
said hereditaments and premises with any summe of
money not exceeding the summe of Ten thousand pounds
for the portion of such daughter to be payable at her age
of Eighteen years or day of Marriage which first shall
happen and not before And if he shall happen to have
two or more such daughters then with any summe of
money not exceeding the summe of Twelve thousand
pounds to be payable to two or more such daughters
in equall proportions and at such times and in such
manner as the said portion for one such daughter was
to have been paid as aforesaid And if my said son George
shall dye without Issue or having Issue they shall dye all
before Marriage I will and devise that if I shall have
only one daughter and no son by my now wife then the
summe of six thousand pounds shall be raised by my said
