them five pounds And I give to my Granddaughter & sister wife of M<sup>r</sup> E.  
Francis Sedgwick twenty shilling to buy her a Ring or Locket to wear in  
remembrance of me And I do hereby revoke all former Wills Bequests and  
appointments made by me And do declare this to be my last Will In witness  
whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament contained in three Sheets  
of Paper to each of the said Sheets set my hand and Seal the Day and year
