

Peter Smitton b 1844 Auchterarder , son of Matthew Smitton & Margaret Callum. (Note there are various Peter Smitton/Smeaton b Auchterarder within a few years of 1844)

On 1851 & 1861 census in Auchterarder with his family. 1871 census I could not find him anywhere.

Marriage: 2 Sep 1874 • Church of the Holy Trinity, Gibraltar

Peter Smeaton, son of Matthew a clerk married Elizabeth Morrison daur of Jose? Morrison (his occupation "gentleman") both with residence at the Kings Arms Hotel.(Got from Find my past! but none of children appear to have been registered in Gibraltar)
