I Sarah Goldsmith of Charlott Place in the Parish of Woodwina in the County of Kent widow being of sound mind but aware of the uncertainty of human life do make and ordain this my last Will and testament and first of all I commit my soul unto God through the merits of my redeemer my worldly goods I dispose of as follows I bequeath unto my son William Goldsmith a sum of five pounds Sterling to my daughter Selia Goldsmith I bequeath the two silver table spoons my freehold house situated in New Street in the parish of Saint Andrew's Deptford I direct to be sold to meet the as a expenses of administration and funeral and to pay my just debts To my son Charles Goldsmith and Thomas Goldsmith I bequeath my freehold house situated at St. 13 in St. James Place in the Parish of Woodwina jointly and now in the occupation of Mr. Augustus Evelyn To my son George Goldsmith and to my daughter Sarah Ann Goldsmith I bequeath my dwelling house situated in Charlott Place jointly And to my daughter Sarah Ann I direct bequeath all my domestic furniture linen and the contents of my plate my freehold house situated at St. 14 in St. James Place and now in the occupation of my son William aforesaid I direct to be sold and the proceeds of the proceeds after my debts are paid to be equally divided between the whole of my children who may be living at the time of my decease And I hereby nominate and appoint Mr. William Stuart of St. James Place in the Parish of Woodwina and Mr. William Fleming of Charlott Place to be my Executors = Sarah Goldsmith X her mark = In = signed sealed and delivered this 18 day of December 1840 in the presence of = Henry Roberts = John Richards = Thomas Richardson =
