Unknown 1	Row B-2	Is presumed to be Major Richard Cooper-White - WO.117-1147 record re: General Hospital No:9, Date 12th June 1940, states "The bodies of Major R Cooper-White & Pte. Allison were brought in for burial, the former appears from evidence to have shot himself & the latter was electrocuted." CWGC confirm that exhumation suggested injuries to body in this grave to be consistent	
Unknown 2	Row C-12	Is known to be a soldier of the Royal Artillery. CWGC confirmed exhumation found button from uniform of the Royal Attilery	
Unknown 3	Row C-15	Unknown Service Man - Died June 1940	Casualty record of Sgn. Edmund Roberts confirms he died in General Hospital No: 9 13th June 1940, which was in Le Grand Luce. WO.117-1147, Date 13th June 1940 confirms 1 Army OR died that day. Same document Date 14th June says that 3 RAF OR were brought into the mortuary "arrangements for their burial by the local Curi were made late that night & money to cover the cost of coffins & burial. Two were identified & one unknown".
Unknown 4	Row C-16	Unknown Service Man - Died June 1940	
Vacant 1	Row C-14	Graves showing cross markers in photo	CWGC have confirmed to me that the bodies of 2 RAF servicemen were exhumed from the graves at Row C- 14 & 15. Is it possible these are the two RAF OR who were identified, but not named, in WO.117-1147 date 14th June 1940? And the third, unidentified, is in either Row C 14 or 15?
Vacant 2	Row C-13	taken at burial of RAF crew 30/01/1946
