Other Information	<p>a) Email from Susan ROGERS in 2021: My mother told me that Susan died when Eliza was a few years old. Eliza could not remember much about her early life. She remembered nuns and her mother wanting her to be brought up catholic. I have found Eliza in the 1901 and 1911 Census. Her school registration gives her address as 17 Perring Street and in 1891 George ROGERS her father was living there but Eliza was not listed in the Census Returns. I have been unable to locate her in the 1891 Census. I have all sorts of stories from my mother about George ROGERS but have been unable to pin down his age. In the three census that I have located him gives a different age, and it is a common name. My mother remembers visiting him with her older brother but cannot remember when he died. I have bought a quantity of death certificates for George about the time and place that he died but none of them match.</p> <p>b) The 1891 census record is recorded but these show George ROGERS married to Clara ROGERS living at 17 Perring Street, Bromley. The 1901 census is also recorded for the same address and this shows George and Clara ROGERS again but this time with another George ROGERS (shown as widowed and a lodger) and Eliza ROGERS (shown as niece. There is also a school admission record showing Eliza living at 17 Perring Street, Bromley and her father as George ROGERS. The conclusion from this is that George (lodger) and Eliza ROGERS (niece) in the 1901 census are my relatives and they are potentially living with George's brother or uncle.</p> <p>c) Despite significant research and the purchase of likely certificates, it has not been possible to find any other records for George ROGERS or his wife Susan ROGERS nee CLARK</p> <p>d) The occupations for George ROGERS on the birth and baptism records are Ticket Writer and Writer respectively. Feedback from RootsChat.com states that this is someone who produced handwritten or painted signs advertising goods or services for sale so that fits with the other records we have showing him as a painter.</p>
