**I**n the name of God: Amen. The Thirde day of  
January in the year of our Lord God according to the computation of the Church of  
England One Thousand Five hundred and Thre, I Christopher Wyn of Berthby in  
the County of Denbigh Esquire findinge by my greates paine and by diligent enquiry and of my neighbours  
that the tyme of my dayes tenneth be farr off, and thirteynge fylle in this estate of health and memory  
wherein I thynke God shalld sende me, to sette in order such matters substance as God of his greates goodnes  
hath bestowed upon me to dispose thereof amongst my children and grandchildren that he on preferred  
after my decesse according to my presente estate wherunto I have speccial regard in such sort as that my  
legacies may be satisfied and discharged without any greates burthen to myne executor then he is habile  
to beare, do therefore not onely write and make wrytes all former wrytes, legacies, and bequestes by me heretofore  
made, but also do hereby make, sette downe, and declare my laste will and testament in every thinge in  
manner and forme followinge. I firste I comend my soule to the hande of Allmyghtie God by whose grace  
and passion I suffere this beledd to obtayne remission of my synnes, and to be partaker of his goodly blesse  
amongst the blessed companye of Saints in heauen. And my bodye I do comytte to the earth from  
whence yt came to be decently buried in christen buriall at the discrecion of my executor. Item I do  
give and bequeathe to the church of Llanroosil five shillinges eight pence towards the payme of the church  
of Llanroosil five shillinges eight pence. To the pore of the same parisse Twentye shillinges. To the  
pore of Llanmagan Twentye shillinges. To the pore of Maentwrog Twentye shillinges. And to  
the pore of Malyuan Thre poundes. Item I geve to the yonger children of Edmunde ap Iff  
Wyn begotten upon the bodye of Ellen his late wyfe beinge my daughter the some of One hundred  
poundes to be equally divided betwene them (savynge his eldest daughter whom I have before to my  
preference sith the makinge of my former will. Item I geve to the yonger children of Hywel  
Bedwda begotten upon the bodye of his late wyfe beinge my daughter the some of a hundred poundes  
to be equally divided betwene them. Item I geve and bequeathe to the yonger children of John Iorda  
of Abertgely begotten upon the bodye of his late wyfe beinge my daughter the some of a hundred  
poundes to be equally divided betwene them. Item I geve and bequeathe to the daughter of my  
sonne Juggo Wyn a hundred poundes to be equally divided betwene them. Item I geve to my sonne  
Edmon Wyn a hundred poundes. And to my sonne Tholte Wyn a hundred poundes. Item I geve and

bequeathe to Edmunde Wyn
